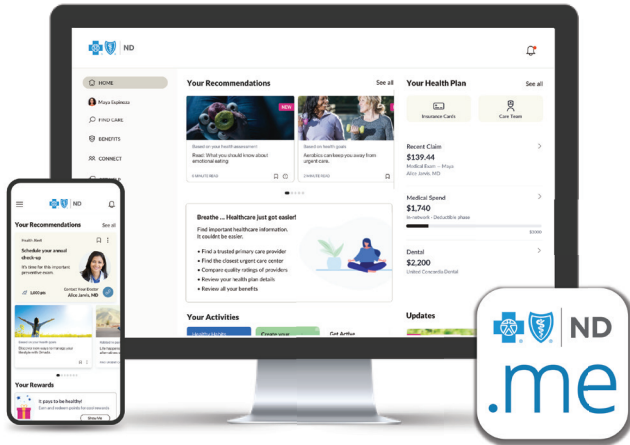

## Definitions

**Deductible:** The dollar amount paid by you for certain covered services during the benefit period.

**Coinsurance:** A percentage of the allowed charge for covered services that is your responsibility. Some medical providers may require that the coinsurance amount be paid at the time of service.

**Formulary drug:** A preferred drug on the formulary drug list.

**Nonformulary drug:** A drug not on the formulary drug list.

**Out-of-pocket maximum (OOPM):** The most you will pay for covered services received during the benefit period, which includes applicable cost sharing amounts (copays, deductibles and coinsurance). After that, BCBSND pays 100% for covered expenses. The benefit period is on a calendar year (January 1 through December 31). The OOPM amount does not include the nonformulary drug sanction amounts.
