What is the overall deductible ?	In-Network: \$2,000 Individual / \$4,000 Family; Out-of-Network Provider : \$4,000 Individual / \$8,000 Family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan , each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care and services indicated in chart starting on page 2.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?
